


How to apply for an absentee ballot in Wisconsin

1. Open an internet browser on your computer. For example, open Chrome , Internet Explorer , or Firefox .

2. Type the URL **myvote.wi.gov** into the search bar, and press **enter** on your keyboard.



3. If you are already registered to vote, click **Vote Absentee**.



4. Type your first name, your last name, and your date of birth into the appropriate fields. Then click **Search**.

5. If the program brings up you name and current address and the status “registered,” click **Request Absentee Ballot**.

6. If your name and Wisconsin address are correct, click in the box next to “The above address and name are mine and correct. A check mark will appear. Then click **Validate Address and Continue**.

7. Select which elections you would like an absentee ballot for by clicking in the circle or square of your selection. (Selected circles will show up filled in. Selected squares will show a check mark.) If you are a qualified elector meeting all of the criteria listed, also click the box that indicates that. Then click **Request Ballot**.

8. Take a picture of the front of your Wisconsin driver license, Wisconsin state ID card, Military ID card, Veteran's ID card, U.S. Passport, or other acceptable photo ID for voting. Save the photo onto your computer with a name you will remember in a location you will remember. For example, you could save it as "Photo ID" on your Desktop. Click **Add Files +**. Select the file, and then click open. Your image will show up under the words Add Files; then click **Continue**.

YOU HAVE NOT YET REQUESTED YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT!

Our records show that you do not have a photo ID on file with your municipal clerk. You will need to upload a copy of your acceptable photo ID for voting below. You can scan your ID or you can even use your phone or computer to take a picture. Your clerk cannot issue you an absentee ballot until they receive your acceptable ID. The clerk also cannot issue you a ballot if the ID you submit is not acceptable for voting purposes.



Please send an image of the front of your Wisconsin driver license, Wisconsin state ID card, Military ID card, Veteran's ID card or U.S. Passport. There are also other photo ID's that can be used for voting, [please click here for the full list](#). Use the 'Add Files' button to find the file or photo of your photo ID on your computer or phone. **DO NOT SUBMIT A SELFIE OR OTHER PORTRAIT OF YOURSELF- THIS IS NOT ACCEPTABLE ID FOR VOTING. TO RECEIVE A BALLOT, YOU MUST UPLOAD AN ACCEPTABLE PHOTO ID FOR VOTING.**
