# Gun Reform is Wildly Popular

The vast majority of Wisconsinites and Americans support stronger gun laws. Polls consistently show that support for some lifesaving gun laws tops 80%.

#### **Background Checks on All Gun Sales**

- 87% of Wisconsinites support universal background checks.<sup>1</sup>
- This makes background checks more popular than beer or cheese.<sup>2</sup>
- A June 2022 poll by Quinnipiac University revealed that 92 percent of Americans support background checks for all buyers, calling this number "near unanimous."<sup>3</sup>

#### **Extreme Risk Laws**

- A Marquette Law School poll from May 2023 shows that 85% of Americans want extreme risk laws, including 83% of gun owning households.<sup>4</sup>
- Wisconsinites are no different; 81% support extreme risk laws.<sup>5</sup>

### **Disarming Domestic Abusers**

- 81% of people support temporarily removing guns from someone subject to a domestic violence restraining order.
- 79% of gun owners polled support this policy.<sup>6</sup>

### **Arming School Staff**

- Most Americans do not favor arming teachers and school administrators, even if the law requires them to be trained.<sup>7</sup>
- Only 20% of educators believe schools would be safer if teachers carried guns.<sup>8</sup>

## **Reducing Gun Violence**

- In an AP/NORC national poll conducted in August of 2023, 78% of respondents said reducing gun violence is extremely or very important.<sup>9</sup>
- 85% of Americans say it's extremely or very important to them to prevent mass shootings. This includes 81% of Republicans.<sup>10</sup>
